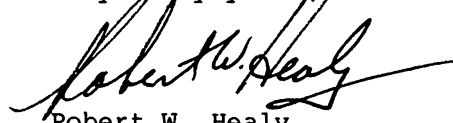

To the Honorable, the City Council:

- In response to City Council Order No. 4 of April 7, 1986, the Traffic Department has met with representatives of the MBTA concerning traffic congestion caused by the double parking of trackless trolleys and buses on Garden Street near the Cambridge Common. As a result of the meeting, a standing area has been created for buses at the corner of Garden Street and Waterhouse Street. This is the only available site as it still allows enough room for buses to turn the corner.
