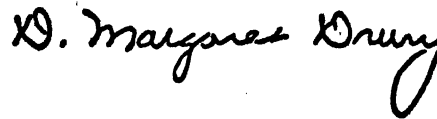

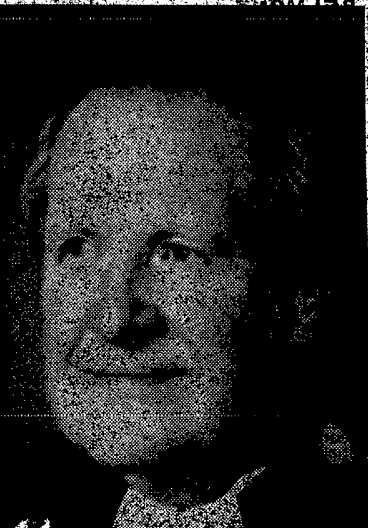

Rev. Charles C. Forman

Was minister, professor at

The Rev. Charles Conrad Forman, affiliate minister at King's Chapel in Boston and retired professor of religion at Wheaton College in Norton, died of cardiac arrest Sunday in his home in Plymouth. He was 71.

Rev. Forman was minister of First Parish Church in Hubbardston and First Parish Church in Plymouth before becoming associate minister at King's Chapel in Boston in 1980. He was also minister in charge of a team ministry at Chiltonville Congregational Church in Plymouth since 1975.

Following his retirement as professor at Wheaton College in 1995, he was a member of the board of trustees of Bridgewater State College.

He was born in Anderson, Ind. He graduated from Tufts College, earned divinity degrees at Harvard and Oxford universities and earned a doctorate in Near Eastern languages and literature at Harvard University.

He leaves his wife, Elizabeth (Parker); three sons, Charles of Norwell, and Peter and Philip, both of Plymouth; a sister, Afton Hillenbrand of Allentown, Pa.; and five grandchildren.

A memorial service will be held at 2 p.m. Saturday in First Parish Unitarian Church in Plymouth.
