- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Attorney Joseph P. Healey, a late Cambridge resident and political figure; and
- WHEREAS: Joseph was a graduate of Harvard College, Harvard Business and Harvard Law School, and served on the faculty of Boston College Law School for fourteen years; and
- WHEREAS: Attorney Healey, among many of his accomplishments, served as a member and Chairman of the University of Massachusetts Board of Trustees for twenty-two years and as a member of the Massachusetts Board of Higher Education, where he led the successful search in the 1960's for a permanent Boston campus for the University of Massachusetts; and
- WHEREAS: Joseph served as Chief Speech Writer for the late President John F. Kennedy during his early political career and was appointed by President Kennedy in 1961 to the Governing Council of the Administrative Council of the United States; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the entire Healey family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the family on behalf of the entire City Council.
