WHEREAS: The Community Development Department will be working with the East Cambridge Planning Team to develop a strategy for investing some \$3.5 million in neighborhood improvements; and

WHEREAS: These improvements will enhance the quality of life for generations of East Cambridge residents; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That all residents of East Cambridge are urged to work with the East Cambridge Planning Team in establishing a neighborhood stabilization program and a schedule of improvements which will meet the needs of the neighborhood to the fullest possible extent; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the Cambridge Community Development Department begin a process for community involvement as soon as possible and further provide the East Cambridge Planning Team and the residents with the necessary technical assistance and resources to carry out this process.
