On behalf of the Harvard Square Business Association, I would like to request your permission to hold our 13th annual Oktoberfest in Harvard Square on Sunday, October 13, 1991 (with a raindate set for Columbus Day, Monday, October 14) from noon to 6 p.m. on JFK and Brattle streets.

Specifically, we are requesting permission, as follows:

1) To hold a non-alcoholic street fair on two blocks of JFK street (from the corner of Mt. Auburn street to Church street) and on part of Brattle street (up to Church street) on Sunday, October 13, 1991, with provision for a raindate Monday, October 14, 1991;

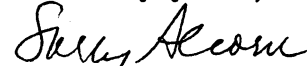
2) Overnight posting on October 12 (or October 13), in order to close part of JFK and Brattle street off to traffic with sawhorses on Sunday from 9:00 a.m. until 7:30 p.m., to allow time for set-up before and clean-up afterwards;

3) Placing kiddie rides in Harvard Square behind a temporary bandstand offering free, public entertainment at the intersection of Brattle and JFK street, in both cases leaving a 12-foot fire lane open for emergency vehicles.

The Harvard Square Business Association would again be responsible for providing supervision, public facilities, clean-up, and security for the Harvard Square Oktoberfest.

We would be delighted if the Mayor or City Councillors decide to attend the Harvard Square Oktoberfest on Sunday, October 13 (or the rain date, Monday, October 14.) Thank you again for your help and cooperation.
