That a Joint Special Committee be appointed to confer with a similar committee of the City Council of the City of Boston with reference to such further action as it may be deemed expedient to take, under the provisions of Chapter 150 of the Acts of 1882, entitled an "act to authorize the Cities of Boston and Cambridge to construct and maintain a bridge across Charles River."

Said Committee to consist of His Honor the Mayor and three members of this board with such as the Common Council may join, - together with the City Solicitor and the City Engineer.
