- WHEREAS: Robert was elected to serve as the vice president of the Massachusetts Bar Association; and
- WHEREAS: Robert was elected to serve as a United States Congressman for five consecutive terms from 1971-1981; and
- WHEREAS: Robert is presently a professor at the Georgetown University Law Center; now therefore be it
