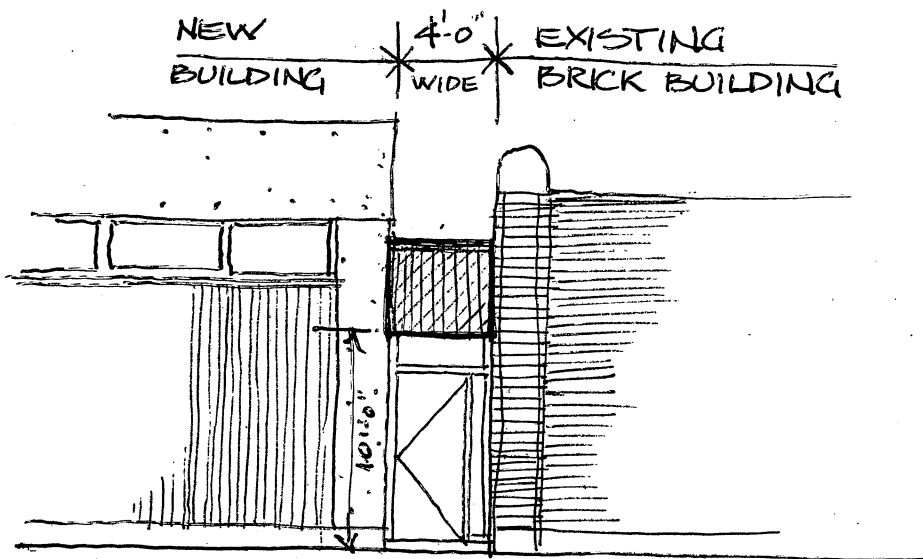
Provided that, before erecting the above named canopy, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Building Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said canopy.

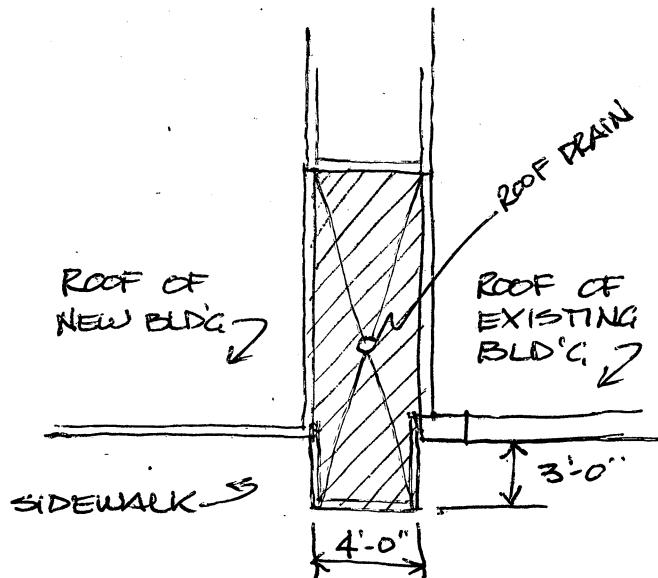

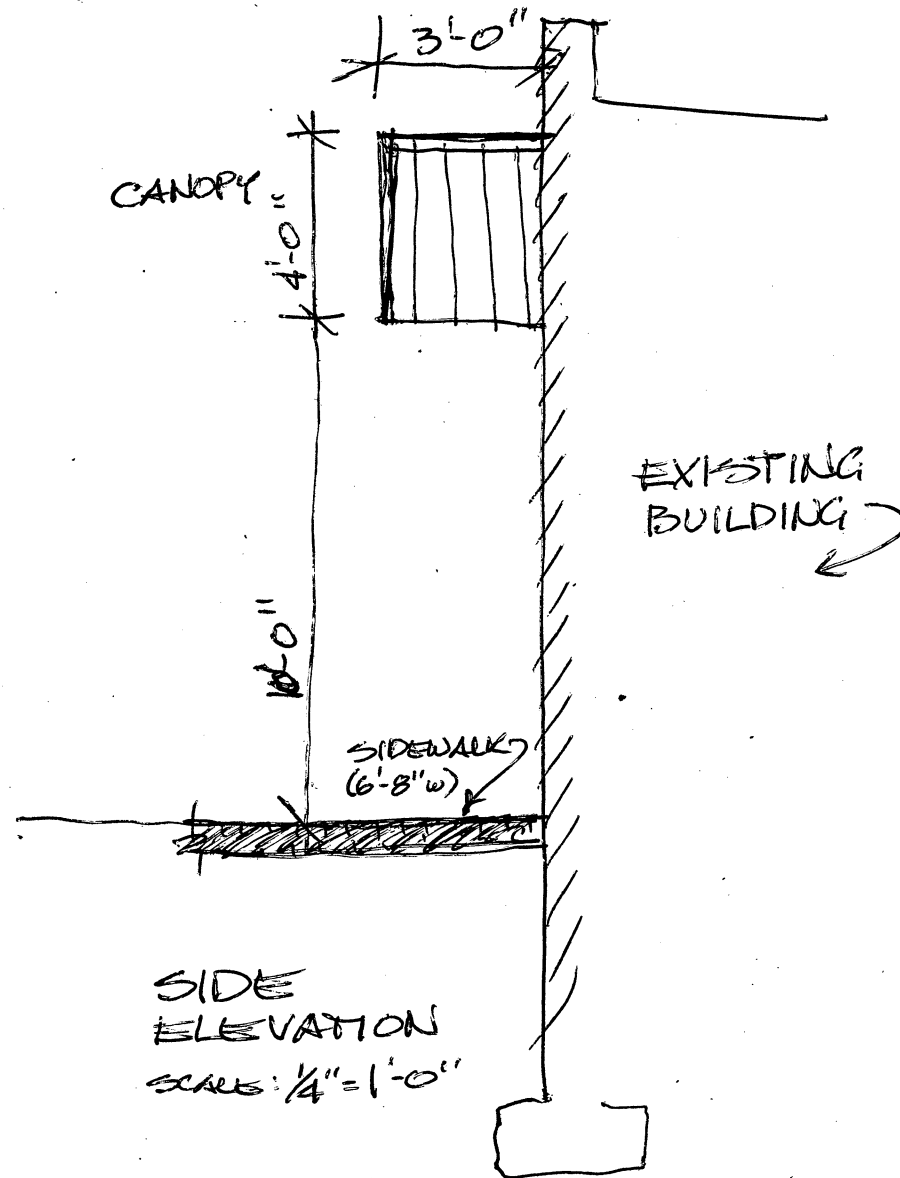

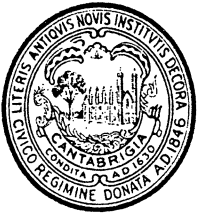
FRONT ELEVATION
