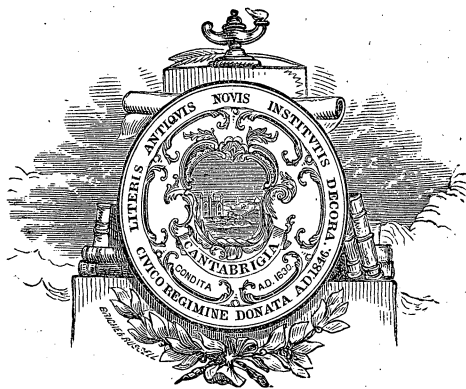


CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.



In Board of Mayor and Aldermen, Nov. 30. 1864.

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Board, the safety and convenience of the inhabitants require that *Sparks Street, so called, between Brattle Street and Vassall Lane,* *Street* should be *laid out* as a public highway,

it is therefore hereby Ordered, that due notice be given to *the owners of* lands abutting on *said street,* and all other persons interested,

that this Board intends to *lay out* the Street before mentioned, by taking a portion of *their* land and laying out the same as a public street—and that *Wednesday,* the *14th* day of *December* next, at *8* o'clock, P. M., is assigned as the time for hearing any objections which may be made thereto.
