To the Honorable, the City Council:

As the end of the fiscal year approaches, some necessary transfers will be needed to maintain appropriation control as part of the end-of-year close-out process. The majority of these transfers involve funding departmental salary and wages accounts from the Salary Adjustment account. The funding for the Salary Adjustment account was approved in the FY03 Adopted Budget. The City Council in the past has authorized the City Manager to make necessary transfers from available balances to those needing supplementals to avoid budget overruns.

Passage of this order will permit the same activity to occur this year.
