In the year One Thousand Eight-Hundred
and Sixty-six.

An Ordinance

in relation to the Compensation of the School
Committee and of the Secretary of said Board.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City
of Cambridge, as follows:-

Sect. 1. The members of the School Committee
shall, from and after the first Monday of
January last past, be paid for the services
rendered by them in their official capacity,
at the rate of One Hundred Dollars each,
per annum.

Sect. 2. The Secretary of the School Com-
mittee, when not a member of the Board,
shall be paid for the services rendered by
him in said capacity, at the rate of Two
Hundred Dollars per annum.
