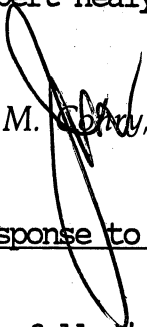

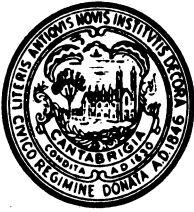
SUBJECT: Response to Council Order #1 Dated 5/20/91 - Surplus School Buses:

The following is in response to the above Council Order;

1. The School Department is soliciting competitive sealed bids for the replacement of three 29-passenger school buses which can no longer be used to transport students after this year, in accordance with state school bus safety regulations (over 10 years old).
2. The bid document also requests trade-in values on these used buses, to be taken at the option of the School Department.
3. If the trade-in values offered are not significant, we may be able to offer them to other City Departments, as an alternative.
4. The bids are due July, 1991.
