In City Council,

WHEREAS:-

The School Committee of the City of Cambridge at its meeting on January 18, 1972 voted that written notice be given to Superintendent of Schools, Frank J. Frisoli, that the School Committee does not intend to reappoint him as Superintendent of Schools of Cambridge for the school year commencing in September of 1972 and ending in 1973, and

WHEREAS:-

The question of the removal of Frank J. Frisoli as Superintendent of Schools has caused much turmoil and division of opinion among the citizens of Cambridge who desire the opportunity to express themselves on this most important matter involving the future course of education of the school children of Cambridge, and

WHEREAS:-

Chapter 43, Section 43 of the General Laws provides a method by which the citizens of Cambridge can be heard on this question, and reads as follows -

Section 43. Submission of proposed measure to voters

The city council may, of its own motion, and shall, upon request of the school committee if a measure originates with that committee and pertains to the affairs under its administration, submit to a vote of the registered voters of the city for adoption or rejection at a general or special city election any proposed measure, or a proposition for the repeal or amendment of any measure, in the same manner and with the same force and effect as are hereby provided for submission on petition. and

WHEREAS:-

This City Council wishes to provide an opportunity for the citizens of Cambridge to be heard on the question of the retention of Frank J. Frisoli as Superintendent of Schools, therefore be it

ORDERED:-

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the City Solicitor to prepare in proper legal form the question of the retention of Frank J. Frisoli as Superintendent of Schools for inclusion on the ballot at the next general or special election, as the City Council in its discretion shall decide, for the consideration of the registered voters of the City of Cambridge, and be it further

ORDERED:-

That the City Solicitor be and hereby is requested to submit his draft to the City Council prior to its meeting of January 24, 1972 for further transmittal to the Board of Election Commissioners.
