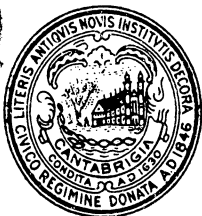


To the Honorable, the City Council:

I transmit herewith communication from the Planning and Development Department requesting an appropriation to the Non Revenue Gore/Alberico Account in the sum of \$37,413.36, said sum to be included in and made part of the 1972 Tax Levy.
