

CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

In Board of Aldermen, June 3, 1890.

Ordered,

That the Committee on Roads and Bridges be authorized to lease the old gas house property near the foot of Bath Street, for the term of five years, at a rental of not exceeding Two Hundred and seventy five dollars (\$275.-) a year. The Cambridge Gas Light Company to have the right to sell the property in the meantime, due allowance being made to the city for such expense as may be incurred in fitting up.

The expense of the foregoing to be charged to the appropriation for Street Department, (Maintenance)
