- WHEREAS:** Mid-Cambridge has the highest residential density of any city neighborhood, and
- WHEREAS:** Mid-Cambridge has the largest concentration of municipal buildings of any city neighborhood, and
- WHEREAS:** Such population, density, and municipal buildings contribute to severe traffic and parking congestion, now therefore be it
- RESOLVED:** That the Cambridge City Council goes on record to support parking relief (utilizing the resident parking sticker program) based on the concept of need, and be it further
- RESOLVED:** That the City Manager is hereby requested to work with the Traffic Commissioner in implementing the resident parking sticker program in all of Mid-Cambridge as soon as possible.
