**WHEREAS:**

Edward J. Fitzgerald, a former employee of the Fire Department of the City of Cambridge, entered the service of the Fire Department on December 9, 1920 and was pensioned on September 22, 1945 under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 57 of the General Laws and died on February 8, 1976, having served not less than thirty-five years, and

**WHEREAS:**

At the time of his death said employee had no rights to elect that benefits be paid to his survivor, said employee leaves as his survivor, his widow, Mrs. Mary E. Fitzgerald, who has not remarried and is not receiving any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any general or special law, therefore be it

**ORDERED:**

That, under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 95A of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition and amendments thereto, that in order to promote the public good, and in consideration of the long and meritorious service performed by Edward J. Fitzgerald, an annuity be granted to Mrs. Mary E. Fitzgerald, of \$3000.00 per year as long as she does not remarry.




