RESOLVED:-

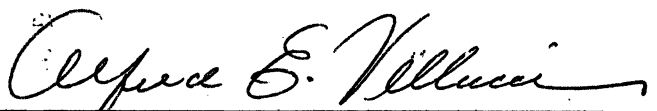
