WHEREAS: The City Council received notice on January 10, 1994 of the resignation of George Teso, Director of Traffic and Parking; and

WHEREAS: Issues concerning traffic and parking in Cambridge have, in the last decade, greatly increased in number and complexity, with a far greater number of vehicles registered in Cambridge, a much higher volume of through-traffic, including truck traffic on residential streets, proposed expansions of capacity at Route 2 and at the Charles River Crossing, and the potential for redirection of federal highway funds to pedestrian, bicycle and mass transit improvements under the recently enacted ISTEA (Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act); and

WHEREAS: The Director of Traffic and Parking will have to call upon a wide variety of interdisciplinary skills and resources to address these and future concerns; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report to the Council to present a plan for hiring a new Director of Traffic and Parking, that this plan include a full job description, an evaluation of the current organization of the department and its coordination with the Department of Community Development, and that this plan assess the feasibility of any public participation in the selection process, including the use of a citizen advisory committee similar to that used in the selection of the Managing Director/Acting Commissioner of Inspectional Services.

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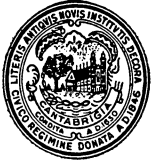
