It would be advantageous to have off-site parking, and

WHEREAS:

There exists a site consisting of .86 acres that is currently vacant on Hovey Avenue which would be suitable for off-site parking, now therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That the Cambridge City Council goes on record as being in favor of acquiring this site on Hovey Avenue for off-site parking contingent upon the State School Building Assistance Bureau approving such a plan and indicating its eligibility for 65% reimbursement.



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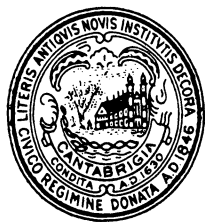

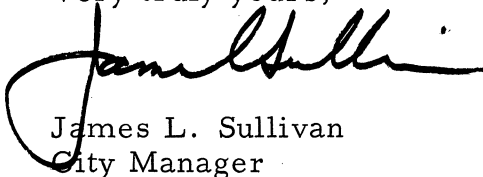
