- WHEREAS: It was 10 years ago, on July 21, 1976, that the New School of Music was founded by the late eminent Boston composer, pianist and educator Nicholas Van Slyck; and
- WHEREAS: The New School of Music began with a faculty of 12 and student body of 36, and has grown to include a faculty of 40 and student body of 450; and began in a storefront on Concord Avenue, moving in 1980 to the historic Lowell School House with the support of the Cambridge City Council and neighborhood; and
- WHEREAS: The New School of Music provided the highest quality music education at affordable fees for all members of the community who so desire, and as well has presented frequent free concerts as a community service; and
- WHEREAS: The New School of Music has sponsored free music instruction for children and senior citizens who would otherwise not be able to afford them, and sponsored the free Cambridge Community Chorus for all who like to sing; and
- WHEREAS: The dedicated faculty and Board of Trustees, many of whom have been with the School since its founding, and current administration under the leadership of director David Deveau are committed to insuring the school's continued success; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council hereby congratulates all members of the New School of Music family for their significant contribution to the cultural life of Cambridge; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That this City Council express to the New School its best wishes for continued success and service to the Cambridge community.
