WHEREAS: This makes it clear that our elderly public housing residents still are fearful of their lives and safety because of the poor security at the L.B.J. Apartments, therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to meet with officials of the Cambridge Housing Authority to seek an immediate solution to this problem, and be it further

ORDERED: That the Mayor be and hereby is requested to arrange for a meeting between this City Council and the Secretary of the State Department of Community Development in order to seek State support and funding on this very serious issue.
