In Board of Aldermen, April 16, 1873.

The Committee on Roads & Bridges to which was refer'd the petition of Kierman Atkinson and others for widening of Appian Way. Reports

That public convenience and necessity, in the opinion of the Committee, do not require that said Street be widened; and parties have built so close to the line of this thirty foot Street that the expense of widening would probably be ~~it~~ considerably more than the petitioners expect; but your committee

recommends, that whenever s^d petitioners or abutters shall have furnished a plan and profile of said Street, showing ~~the~~ it to be widened to such extent as they may desire, and also released the City from all claims for damages thereby incurred, the s^d Street as widened be accepted by the City.
