ORDERED:

That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to the Saints Constantine and Helen Greek Orthodox Church for the erection of a banner across Massachusetts Avenue from the premises numbered 625 Massachusetts Avenue to the premises numbered 624 Massachusetts Avenue to announce its Three Day Annual Cultural Festival to be held on Friday, Saturday and Sunday, August 19, 20 and 21, 1988.

Provided that, before erecting the above named banner, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Inspectional Services Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said banner.

Please be advised that the City Council is in receipt of your communication dated May 9, 1988 with regard to your three day Annual Grecian Cultural Festival to be held on August 19-21, 1988.

Pursuant to your communication, the City Council at its regular meeting of May 16, 1988 adopted the enclosed order granting you the necessary permission for the placement of a sign on the City Hall lawn; the closing of Magazine Street from Franklin to Auburn Streets and for the display of a car for the sale of raffle tickets.

The Council also adopted an order granting permission for the hanging of a banner across Mass. Avenue in Central Square announcing the event. 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WHEREAS: Said communication requests permission to erect a sign on the lawn at City Hall for the purpose of announcing this year's Festival; said sign to be placed on the City Hall lawn about a month preceeding this event, from approximately July 20-August 21, 1988; and also for permission to close Magazine Street between Franklin and Auburn Streets from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. during the Festival; therefore be it

ORDERED: That this City Council go on record granting permission for the above requests to the Saints Constantine and Helen Greek Orthodox Church, with the provision that during the period of the street closing a fire lane be provided and left open for the Fire Department and any other emergency vehicles; and be it further

ORDERED: That this City Council go on record granting permission to the Saints Constantine and Helen Church for the display of a car for the sale of raffle tickets; said vehicle to be displayed alternately in the legal parking area between the Cambridgeport Savings Bank and the U.S. Trust Bank at the intersection of Massachusetts Avenue and Prospect Street in Central Square, on Cambridge Street in East Cambridge in front of the East Cambridge Savings Bank and at the Twin Cities Mall, and that the Director of Traffic and Parking be requested to take the necessary steps as appropriate to cover the traffic meter in front of the car; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Commissioner of Public Works to confer with the petitioner, relative to the dates the car will be displayed at the above-referenced locations and also with regard to the erection of the sign on the front lawn of City Hall.

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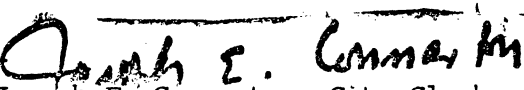
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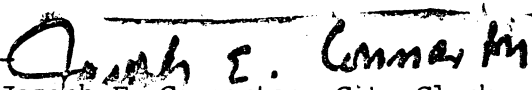
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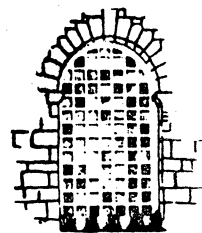
