- WHEREAS: The operator of the bus which picks up children at 7:15 - 7:30 each morning at Corcoran Park blows the horn continuously and, by so doing, disturbs the neighbors unnecessarily; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager direct the Interim Superintendent of the Cambridge School Department to advise the Manager at Vocell Bus Co., Inc. of this undue noise and unacceptable annoyance, and request that remedial action be taken at once which will bring the practice to a halt; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager report back to this Council prior to November 14, 1988 to confirm that the problem has been solved; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to check into the schedule of buses in order to ensure their timely arrival.
