Adopted by the affirmative vote of nine members.

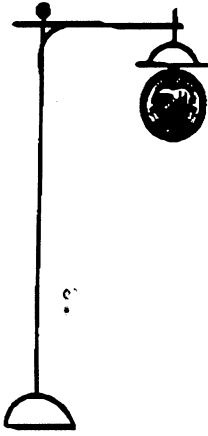

SUB: Council Order # 86, Dated 9/11/95

Re: Installing an Emergency Police Call Box, in Linear Park, between Cambridge and the Somerville line.

It is feasible to install an emergency police call box at this location, and will require Nynex to install aerial cables to this location, or the city must trench to the street to existing Nynex facilities. Presently Nynex does not have telephone cables within the park, however, there are existing poles with electric cables attached, which would allow telephone cables to be attached also, provided that their existing facilities in the area are engineered to provide aerial service to this location.

- Funding to cover the expense would be available from the Electrical Departments current operating budget.
- If Nynex cables are installed on the existing poles, the installation is minimized and would cost \$ 900.00 for equipment and electrical supplies.
- If it is not possible to attach telephone cables to the existing poles, trenching would be required and the cost would be \$ 1,275.00 for equipment and electrical supplies, labor from Public Works for excavating, and cost of materials for restoration of excavated areas, additional \$ 1,000.00.
