- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened at learning of the assassination of Nagasaki Mayor Iccho Itoh, who died from bullet wounds on April 18, 2007 at the age of 61; and
- WHEREAS: Mayor Itoh began his service as Mayor of Nagasaki in 1995; and
- WHEREAS: At the same time Mayor Itoh was elected vice president of the world-wide organization Mayors For Peace, an office he still held at the time of his death; and
- WHEREAS: As Mayor of a city that had been destroyed by an atomic bomb, Mayor Itoh was a passionate and eloquent advocate of the abolition of nuclear weapons; and
- WHEREAS: Mayor Iccho Itoh will be sorely missed by all he touched and loved; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the family of Iccho Itoh at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Itoh family on behalf of the entire City Council.
