To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$45,000 in the Grant Fund of the Community Development Salary and Wages Account (\$3,500), Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$40,300), and Travel and Training Account (\$1,200). The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has awarded funds through the Climate Wise Grant to work with local companies in reducing greenhouse gas emissions that contribute to global warming. CDD will recruit 10 local businesses to voluntarily join the EPA Climate Wise program and will provide technical assistance to at least 5 of these companies on creation of energy efficiency measures and action plans to reduce greenhouse gas emissions.
