An Ordinance in amendment of the Ordinance
in relation to City Messenger,

Be it ordained by the City Council of the
City of Cambridge as follows,

Chapter 16 of the Revised Ordinances is
hereby amended, to read as follows,

CHAPTER XVI.

MESSENGER.

1. Messenger to City Council, how chosen. 2. His duties. His Compensation.

SECT. 1. There shall be chosen annually, in the month of ~~January~~ ^{April}, by concurrent vote of both branches of the City Council, a Messenger to the City Council, who shall hold his office for one year, and until another is chosen in his place, subject to removal, at any time, by the City Council.

SECT. 2. The City Messenger shall attend to the opening and closing of the various rooms in the City Hall, and shall have the care and charge of the same. He shall wait upon all committees and boards when in session at the City Hall, and in general shall perform all services required by the Mayor, by either branch of the City Council, or by such committees or boards,

Sect. 3. The messenger shall appoint ^{an} assistant ~~to~~ subject to the approval of the City Council, who shall hold ~~his~~ his office one year unless sooner removed by him or by the City Council.

Sect. 4. The messenger and his assistant shall receive such compensation as the City Council may from time to time determine.
