- WHEREAS: For many years the Cambridge City Council has been making inquiries on the amount of waiting time Cambridge residents have to wait to be seen at the Emergency Room at the Cambridge Hospital, and
- WHEREAS: The Cambridge Hospital has been repeatedly told that Cambridge residents wait a half hour for treatment in the Emergency Room, and
- WHEREAS: Cambridge residents infact wait two hours for emergency treatment at the Emergency Room at the Cambridge Hospital, therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager instruct the Director of the Cambridge Hospital to place a complaint box at the Emergency Room for the purpose of letting the Cambridge City Council hear from the public exactly what goes on at the Emergency Room of the Cambridge Hospital.
