of Murdock High School in Winchendon, was a cum laude graduate of Berklee School of Music in Boston in 1979.

He belonged to a drum and bugle corps, and later taught up-and-coming musicians. A trumpet player, Mr. Amenta formed his own band, the Soul Dukes, winning awards for his compositions. He also had his own recording studio in the early 1990s.

For the last decade, he worked at Dynamics Research in Newton.

He leaves his sister, Dolores Davis of Sacramento; a brother, Arthur Jr., and his stepmother, Evelyn Amenta, both of Winchendon.
