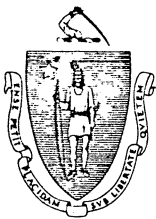

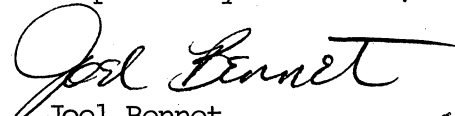
We respectfully request that we be allowed to sell tickets from the sidewalk in Harvard Square on the following dates and at the following times:
