COUNCILLOR GRAHAM

- WHEREAS: Ninety-seven percent of the families on AFDC are headed by single mothers; and
- WHEREAS: Massachusetts AFDC benefits are already at sixty-three percent of the national poverty level; and
- WHEREAS: We can see no positive benefits for Cambridge poor women, their children or the City of Cambridge as a whole; and
- WHEREAS: The Massachusetts Workfare proposal is an act of discrimination against women in general and poor women and children in particular; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council opposes this plan and publicly denounces it by refusing to accept Workfare placements in any city-funded or controlled agency or department.
