COUNCILLOR PREUSSER

- WHEREAS: At my request, plans are now underway for a meeting between the Cambridge City Council, the City Manager, our State Legislative Delegation, and Speaker O'Neill in order to ask the Speaker's assistance in extending the Red Line to Arlington Heights and then out to Route 128; and
- WHEREAS: It is critical that the Red Line extend beyond Cambridge so that it is truly a regional transportation solution which intercepts commuter traffic and keeps it off of our residential streets; and
- WHEREAS: It is equally important that low cost transportation options are available to inner city residents who must go to where the jobs are in the suburbs, particularly in light of a recent ruling by U.S. D.O.T.'s Office of Civil Rights which mandates that public transportation money must be used fairly so as to provide service to poor and minority communities; and
- WHEREAS: Access to the job market is more important than ever for the urban poor given President Carter's voluntary anti-inflationary policies which will almost certainly result in higher levels of unemployment, as opposed to the employment goals of the Humphrey-Hawkins Bill; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to immediately begin to form a working coalition of interests in order to provide whatever assistance we can gather to Speaker O'Neill in the effort to insure that the Red Line goes beyond the City of Cambridge to Route 128; and be it further


