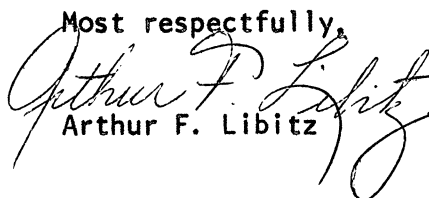
Dear Mr. Healey,
