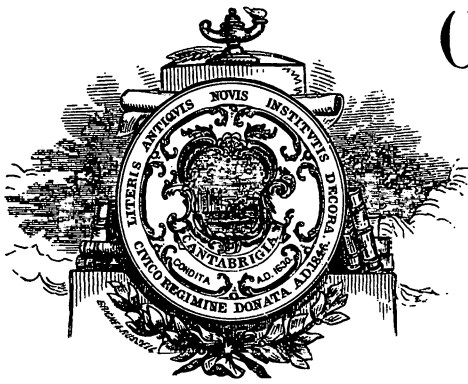




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

IN BOARD OF ALDEEMEN,

Dec, 21, 1874

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Columbia Street
from *Cambridge St.* to the *Somerville Line*
should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *forty five feet*
in width between *Cambridge St. and the Somerville Line*

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by

C. F. Bowker

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid. *and*
that thirty days be allowed for the removal of
all obstructions standing thereon

Same - closed for convenience.
