a way to begin to find the answer as to why there was a rise in crime is to examine the kinds of crimes that were committed.

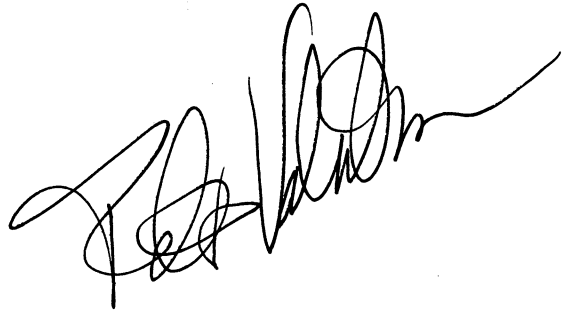
then to see if there were a greater proportion of a certain kind of crime.
