That common sewers be laid in the streets hereinafter named, the same to be built by contract or by the day, with, or without advertising for proposals therefor, at the option of the City Engineer, and the expense thereof to be charged to the appropriation for Sewers (Construction:—Sundry Sewers). Estates benefitted to be assessed according to law.

In Hutchinson Street from Walden Street about two hundred and thirty (230) ft. easterly.

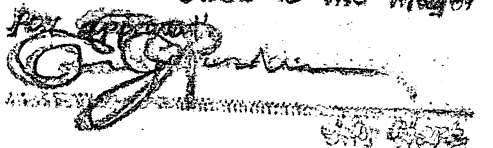
