Dear Mr. Healy,

I have viewed the driveway revisions as proposed by Mr. Raymond Bandar, the manager of the property at 1924 Massachusetts Avenue and recommend that the driveway permit be granted with the following conditions:

1. That the existing driveway be closed by raising the curbing and installing a new sidewalk.
2. That the new driveway be 18 feet in width.
3. That the driveway and service area meet all the requirements of the Zoning Laws of the City of Cambridge.
