ORDERED:

WHEREAS: the School Committee has not yet been informed as to any additional amounts of state or federal financial assistance for FY-84, and

WHEREAS: property tax re-valuations, in their present status, pose particular uncertainties for the School Department because of their implications for the city's ability to generate property tax revenues, and

WHEREAS: the Cambridge School Committee, in both seeking this information and in wishing to involve more citizens in the budget development process, has, at this time, insufficient data so as to present to the City Manager and the City Council a complete educational budget,

THE SCHOOL COMMITTEE HEREBY FORWARDS A PRELIMINARY REQUEST TO THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY COUNCIL FOR THE SUM OF \$44,690,336 AS ITS OPERATING BUDGET FOR FY 1984, SUCH A SUM REPRESENTING THE SCHOOL COMMITTEE'S BEST ESTIMATE, AT THIS TIME, OF THE PRESENT AND REASONABLE NEW AND EXPANDED PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS.

Further, the secretary to the School Committee is directed to forward a copy of this order to the City Manager and to the City Council.
