ORDERED:

That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to The Outback Shop, Inc., for the erection of a banner extending across Mount Auburn Street at the premises numbered 10 Mount Auburn Street, commencing on May 17, 1983 through May 27, 1983, announcing a "tent sale".

Provided that, before erecting the above named banner, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Building Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars, conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said banner.

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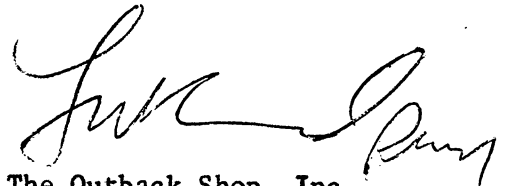

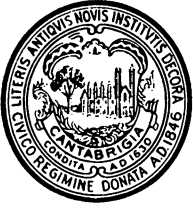
