RESOLVED: That this City Council does hereby request the prompt attention of the Public Works Department to these improprieties wherever they exist, specifically 540-550 Franklin Street, 6 Kinnaird Street, 4 Howard Street, 514 Franklin Street and 472 Green Street; and establish a regular maintenance program.
