Auburn Street in view of the fact the elderly in this city are being victimized on a constant basis; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Chief of Police to report back to the sponsor of this order as Chairman of the Committee on Public Safety in view of the fact the Committee will be conducting public hearings on this issue in the near future.
