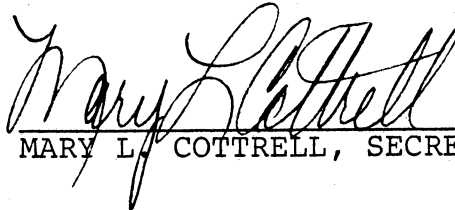

Petition of Deacon Transportation, Inc. d/b/a Old Town Trolley Tours of Boston, requesting that the Department of Public Utilities issue it a certificate of public convenience and necessity for the operation of motor vehicles over certain public ways in Cambridge and Boston and certain public ways under the jurisdiction of the Massachusetts Turnpike Authority and the Metropolitan District Commission, restricted to the carriage of passengers using Old Town Trolley Tours sight-seeing service, under the provisions of G.L. c. 159A, § 7.
