WHEREAS:-

Governor Sargent in 1970 declared a moratorium on the construction of certain highways pending a complete restudy of transportation modes in the Metropolitan area, and

WHEREAS:-

Certain voices are now calling for an immediate end to the moratorium and a resumption of highway construction, and

WHEREAS:-

This City Council believes that the top priority for transportation monies should be for improved public transit available to all ages and income groups, and further that each additional highway leading into Boston brings more unwanted automobiles down town to create additional space and traffic problems, and to add to air and noise pollution, now therefore be it

ORDERED:-

That this City Council respectfully urges Governor Sargent to make said moratorium permanent, or at least to maintain it until an objective study of all transportation modes has been completed.
