To the Honorable, the Cambridge City Council,

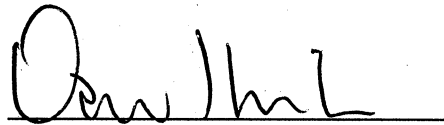
Stop Curb Cuts for 784 Memorial Drive

I am writing to request that the City Council decline to approve curb cuts for the Polaroid/Spaulding & Slye project at 784 Memorial Drive in Cambridgeport.

There are numerous reasons for the City to delay these curb cuts, which have been listed by the many community groups, abutters and neighbors opposed to this massive and un-needed garage and development project. Without reciting them all, as a simple example, the permits for the rest of the proposal have not been finalized, and it is illogical and harmful to permit a garage and curb cuts before the environmental, traffic and other neighborhood concerns have been resolved.

Please do not give curb cut permission to the developer until all the other issues and concerns raised by the community, including the CPort Neighborhood Initiative, have been resolved. Protection of this neighborhood is critical to Cambridge life.
