The City of Cambridge has the opportunity to receive \$150,000 in federal funds for the remodeling of the City Infirmary's West Wing, and

WHEREAS:

The remodeled facility will house the Cambridge Day Care Center currently occupying the old Superintendent's house on the Infirmary's grounds, and

WHEREAS:

The City of Cambridge will lose this funding unless the City Manager applies for a Certificate of Need with the State Health Department and submits a construction contract by July 1, therefore be it

ORDERED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to take whatever steps necessary to secure said monies before the July 1 deadline and report back to this Council on his progress in two weeks.
