The Department of Public Utilities is proposing to amend its procedural rule 220 C.M.R. 35.05 which governs the applications for certificates of public convenience and necessity ("Certificates") of radio common carriers ("RCCs"). The proposed amendment is the repeal of subsection (3) of 220 C.M.R. 35.05. This proposed amendment is intended to expedite the application process for certificates by eliminating the requirement that each applicant for a certificate notify all RCCs in the proposed service area of the application. 220 C.M.R. 35.03 (3) is considered by the Department to be duplicative of the notice requirement in 220 C.M.R. 1.06 (a) and (b) which requires applicants for certificates to place public notice of said application in newspapers of general circulation within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

The above notice is officially captioned:

Investigation by the Department on its own motion regarding amendment of the present regulation 220 C.M.R. 35.05 which relates to the application for certificates of public convenience and necessity for radio common carriers.

The Department will hold a public hearing to receive oral comments on the proposed regulations on Monday, January 13, 1992 at 10:30 a.m., at the Department's hearing room, Room 1210, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Massachusetts.

Written comments on the proposed regulations will be received by the Secretary to the Department. Those wishing to comment at the public hearing are encouraged to submit preliminary written comments by December 30, 1991. Final written comments are due ten days after the close of public hearings.
