- WHEREAS: Charles served his country during World War II as a member of the United States Navy, attaining three Combat Stars and a Philippine Liberation Medal with one star; and
- WHEREAS: Charlie joined the Water Department on July 1, 1946 and has held a variety of positions within the Department and currently is a Working Foreman; and
- WHEREAS: During the Blizzard of '78, Charlie literally held the Water Department together due to the inability of the Superintendent to get to Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: Charlie has been extremely active with the Veterans of Foreign Wars, holding from one time or another all the positions within the Post and became District Commander in 1970 and currently holds the position of State Chief of Staff; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its appreciation and gratitude to Charles H. Sullivan as he completes thirty-five years of continued public service; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Charlie on behalf of the entire City Council.
