The undersigned respectfully pray

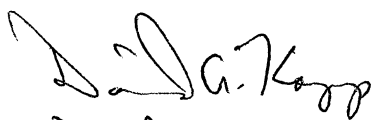
to be permitted to sell novelty items during the 1989
